Subject: No emigration clearances to Recruiting Agents without prior permission for issuance of advertisement for overseas recruitment

Sir,

I am directed to say that guidelines were issued to all the POEs regarding advertisement and conduct of interviews by registered recruiting agents vide this ministry's letter No. Z.11025/59/2004-Emig. dated 17th March,2007. Further, instructions have been issued to the POEs vide this ministry's letter of even number dated 30th April, 2007 for not giving emigration clearance to those recruited through advertisements which are issued not in conformity with the guidelines issued by the Press Council of India.

2. The matter regarding issuance of advertisements by the recruiting agents for overseas recruitment and grant of emigration clearance has been reviewed and it has been decided that no emigration clearance will be given unless permission has been granted by the POE to the recruiting agent for issuance of advertisement.

3. This may be given wide publicity and brought to the notice of the recruiting agents.
